

Parent Code of Conduct

- Parents shall be expected to communicate appropriately with all P&C Staff including volunteers whilst engaging with the P&C Business, Out of hours school care (OSHC), Uniform and Tuckshop and also whilst engaging with P&C staff and volunteers during P&C run events.
- Appropriate communication shall include, but not be limited to:
 - Appropriate Language; and
 - Calm and considerate tone.
- Parents shall not be permitted to discipline verbally or in any other way the children of other families, staff members or volunteers of the P&C. Should a parent have an issue or concern regarding the conduct of another child, family or employee, they shall contact the [Operations Manager](#) via email to commence grievance procedures, if the grievance is with the Operations Manager you should then contact the [President of the P&C](#).
- Parents who breach the conduct expected of them whilst engaging with the P&C may be exposed to appropriate consequences which may result in the exclusion of their family's enrolment with OSHC and ability to attend P&C meetings.
- The Police may be notified if Parent conduct within the P&C staff and/or volunteers is threatening or violent.
